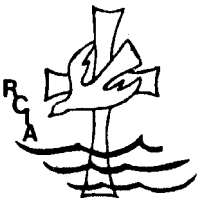
CATHOLIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

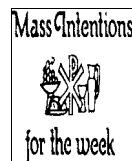
